

BS EN 1398 – “Dock Levellers - Safety Requirements”

This is the UK implementation of the European standard EN 1398:2009 and supersedes BS EN 1398:1998 which is withdrawn.

The UK participation in its preparation was performed by Technical Committee MHE/12, Lifting platforms. Members of this committee include representatives of ALEM members. A list of organizations represented on this committee can be obtained on request to the Committee secretary.

This European Standard specifies the safety requirements for the design, construction, installation, maintenance and testing of dock levellers and for safety components on dock levellers.

It was approved by CEN on 14 February 2009.

CEN members are the national standards bodies of participating countries, with BSI providing the UK input.

CEN members are bound to comply with the CEN/CENELEC Internal Regulations which stipulate the conditions for giving this European Standard the status of a national standard without any alteration. Up-to-date lists and bibliographical references concerning such national standards may be obtained on application to the CEN Management Centre or to any CEN member.

This European Standard exists in three official versions (English, French, German). A version in any other language made by translation under the responsibility of a CEN member into its own language, and notified to the CEN Management Centre, has the same status as the official versions.
